## **Peak 6:**

High Alpine Bliss. The newest expansion opened in 2013. Advanced intermediate - Expert. Offers above tree line, tree skiing, hike to terrain. No base area, accessible from Peak 7

## **Peak 7:**

The easy rider Intermediate paradise. Wide flowing corduroy below the tree line, Advanced bowls above. Low key full service base area.

## **Peak 8:**

Iconic Peak where you can ski from the highest lift in NA right into town. Flagship newest base area. Ski school HQ. Beginner to Expert terrain. .

## **Peak 9:**

Mellow beginner learning areas at the bottom, expansive Intermediates at the top. The most lifts, and two small full service base areas, The Village and Beaver Run. Closest access to Main Street

## **Peak 10:**

The wild child hub of advanced terrain. Steep groomers on the front, Bumps, glades, rock outcroppings on the sides..

- Iconic Lift Access: Peak 8 is home to the [Imperial Super Chair](#), which takes skiers to an elevation of nearly 13,000 feet.

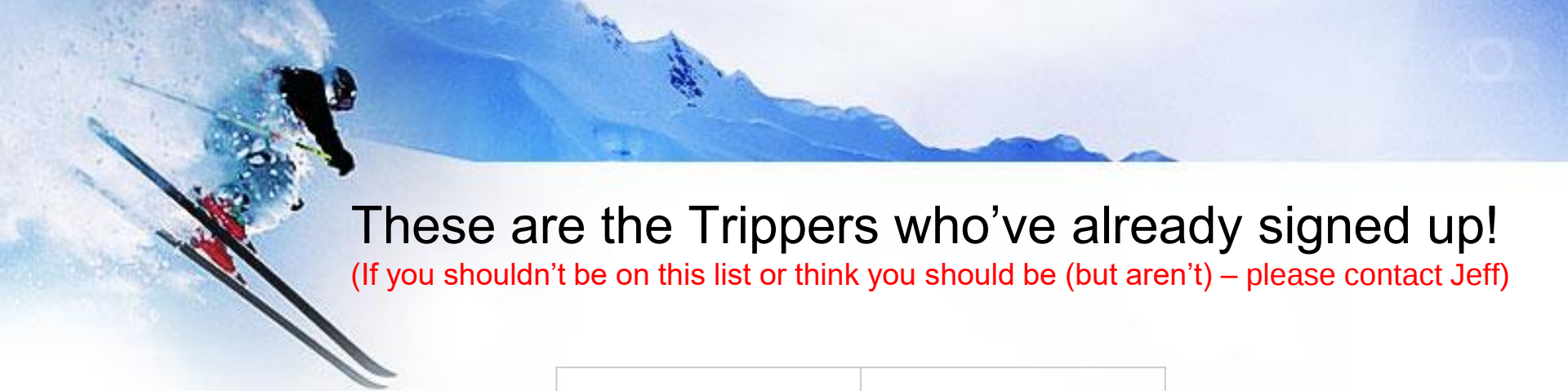

- Breckenridge, Beaver Creek and Whistler trips are all available on the Local Pass and not on peak days.

Local Pass restriction is no more than 10 days total between Beaver Creek and Whistler. Unlimited at Breckenridge

- Prices often increase around
  - ✓ late May or early June
  - ✓ Summer (June–August)
  - ✓ Early Fall (September / Labor Day)
  - ✓ Mid-October
  - ✓ Mid-November (Final Deadline)

- Full Pass - \$1150
- Local Pass - \$809
- Military Pricing - \$215 (Retired & Dependents), \$620 (Veterans) – Valid for all 3 trips
- Multi-Day Passes (All Resorts / No Peak Dates)
  - ✓ 5 Day - \$527
  - ✓ 4 Day - \$451
  - ✓ 3 Day - \$362
  - ✓ 2 Day - \$256
  - ✓ 1 Day - \$138

# How to Register for a Trip

First – you need to be an active member with dues paid!

If you are NOT an active VSC Club member yet, you will need to join/renew and pay the club dues first (\$25pp).

- Trips have been open since the January Club Meeting (emails sent to all members).
- To reserve a trip, you must first register online at our club website: [www.TheVillagersSkiClub.com](http://www.TheVillagersSkiClub.com) (it spells The Villagers Ski Club)
- After registering, Simply logon, and select the TRIP APPLICATION tab, see example to the right.



- Then select the trip that you want to go on from the dropdown, and complete/submit the reservation form. Please make sure that you look at all fields.
- You'll get a confirmation email (if you don't see it, check your Spam/Junk folders and add our email to a Contact to prevent it from happening again).
